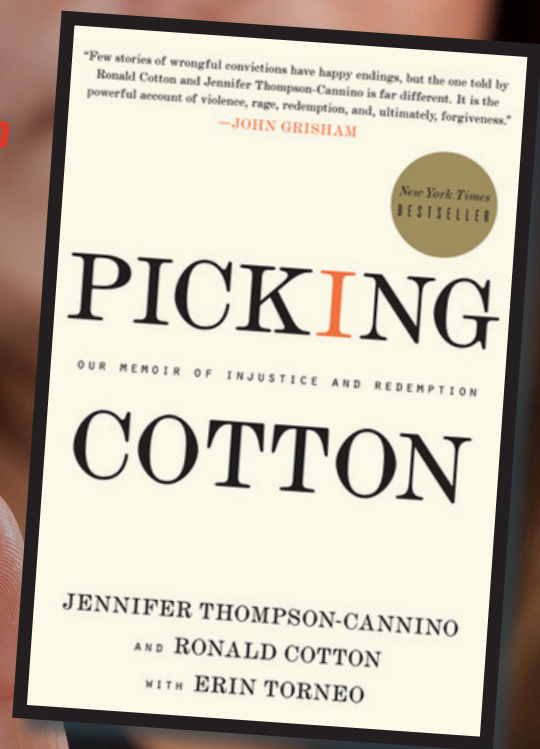


PageTurners Book Club Invites You to Read:

Jennifer Thompson was raped at knifepoint by a man who broke into her apartment while she slept. She was able to escape, and later she positively identified Ronald Cotton as her attacker. Ronald insisted that she was mistaken, but Jennifer's positive identification was the compelling evidence that put him behind bars. After eleven years, Ronald was allowed to take a DNA test that proved his innocence. He was released after serving more than a decade in prison for a crime he never committed. Two years later, Jennifer and Ronald met face-to-face and forged an unlikely friendship that changed both of their lives.
