# JOB SUMMARY:

The Director of University Library is responsible for all aspects of library administration and services, including planning, policy development, personnel, and financial management in accordance with all properly authorized policy and procedures of Saginaw Valley State University.

#### ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Facilitates the continuing transformation of the University Library into a learning commons that integrates diverse resources, collaborates with university units, seeks new opportunities, engages with the community, and sustains a vibrant research and learning community.

- Develops and implements a clear strategic plan that promotes the missions of SVSU and the Zahnow Library.
- Creates an atmosphere that promotes scholarly activity with an understanding of innovative methods of information dissemination.
- Recruits, retains, and leads a high-quality library staff.
- Responsible for overseeing library budget in consultation with the Office of the Provost.
- Communicates internally and externally regarding the University Library.
- Develops strong relationships with Deans, the Provost, President and other University administrators.
- Serves as a liaison to professional state and national networks and organizations.
- Develops, maintains, and advocates good relationships between the library and it's students, faculty, staff and community.
- Works with library and university departments, as well as external sources, to identify, evaluate and implement programs that improve services and facilities, enhance the quality of resources and increase operational efficiency within the libraries.
- Fosters professionalism, diversity and a positive work/learning environment in the University Library.

# MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- An ALA-accredited Master's in Library/Information Science;
- A record of success in increasingly responsible positions as a library administrator in a post-secondary academic environment with five (5) years successful administrative experience;
- Experience in fiscal planning, program planning, personnel, and financial and facilities management;
- Knowledge and ability to appropriately implement emerging technology and trends in the academic library and the university learning community, including information literacy, curriculum driven collections, and the technology of teaching and learning; and
- A record of strong and successful leadership including effective team building, the ability to manage change, and experience building effective partnerships internally and externally to the University.

- Experience with library facilities planning;
- An appropriate additional advanced degree or doctoral degree (i.e., Library/Information Science).
