

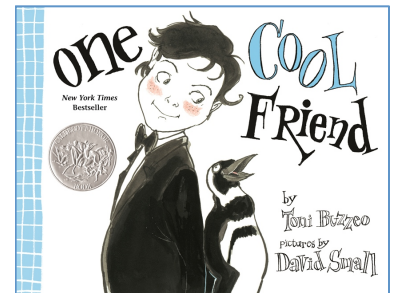
# Young Authors' Festival 2014

## Student Writing Contest

In the book *One Cool Friend* by Toni Buzzeo, Elliot comes home with a very special friend after a trip to the aquarium. Students in 3rd-5th grades are encouraged to enter an original poem, story, or essay focused on friendship in this year's writing contest.

### Contest Rules:

- **Theme: Friendship**
  - You might consider the following: Who or what makes a good friend? What is special about friendship? How have you been a friend to someone? What are the challenges of friendship? How have you changed as a friend? Who is your best friend? How have you celebrated friendship?
- You may enter if you are in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, or 5<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Submit one piece of writing. There's no maximum or minimum length. You may include an illustration.
- Your writing must be original.
- Typed entries are appreciated.
- Three prizes will be awarded to each grade; one grand prize winner will be selected.
- Winners will receive gift cards and be invited to read aloud their entries at the Young Authors' Festival.
- **Do not put your name on the entry. A second sheet must be submitted with the following information:**
  - Name and grade
  - Home address
  - Title of contest entry
  - School name & address
  - Name and e-mail address of sponsoring teacher or parent
