Thousands Needed To Help Break World Record

Nashville, MI, April 10, 2015 - To celebrate the completion of the downtown streetscape project in the rural village of Nashville, located approximately 30 miles from Lansing, the business community invites everyone to help them break the world record for the longest ice cream sundae.
