The Great Saginaw Fire of 1893

On May 20, 1893, a fire destroyed over 250 homes in Saginaw leaving behind crumbling foundations and ashes. Local tradition holds the community refused all outside assistance and made a quick recovery from the disaster. In 2011, a Castle Museum archaeology excavation revealed a very different story.
