- Previous academic library and supervisory experience
- Familiarity with library workflows

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide assistance to Rochester University faculty, students, and the campus community by responding to information requests in person and remotely through phone/email/chat
- Copy catalog and/or create brief MARC records in Alma
- Manage periodical records, back issues and periodical stacks
- Evaluate incoming donations
- Process new and current items
- Sort and reshelve returned books and other materials
- Staff library circulation desk.
- Part-time, \$12 per hour, 10 hours per week, includes evenings and weekend shifts, no summers
